Re: Vulnerable and Key Worker Provision

As you are aware, our vulnerable student and key worker provision is full-time for all 5 days, recommencing on Monday 22 February, until Friday 5 March, 2021. Students who access this provision are working to their normal school timetable, starting and finishing at the usual times of 8.25am and 2.30pm, respectively.

This provision is available to vulnerable students and children of key workers (where at least one parent meets the government's criteria).


Key Worker Provision

Children with at least one parent or carer who is a key worker may access on-site provision in the Academy if required, but parents or carers should keep their children at home if they can.

Since January, we have been fortunate enough to base our year group bubbles in computer rooms, allowing children to take part in "live" lessons. However, we are experiencing high levels of demand and space is at a premium. As a result, we do ask that key workers carefully consider whether they need to access our provision or could possibly keep their children at home. To ensure that this important resource is available to all who need it, we may ask for documentary evidence (i.e. employee ID, letter from employer) to confirm eligibility.

We know how unusual this is to you to keep your child away from school. We are looking forward to the time when we can welcome all of our young people back into the Academy. In the meantime, we ask for your support in making our vulnerable student and key worker provision practicable for those who absolutely need it.
