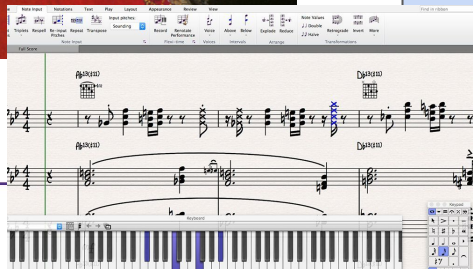
## Need Support?

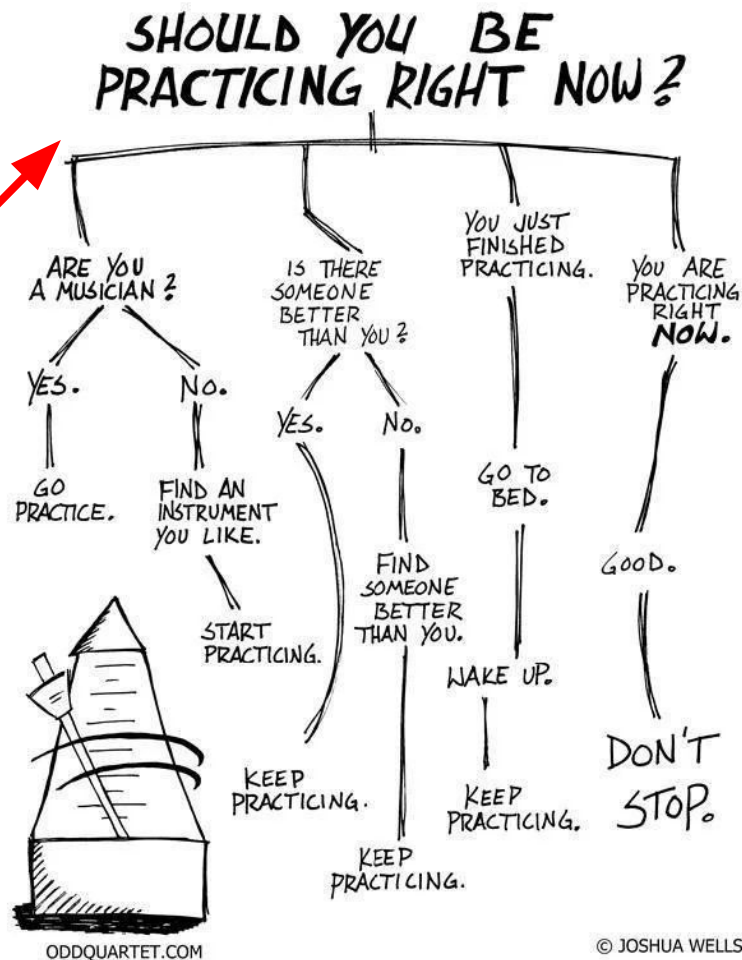


# Music

## What does music homework look like?

- **Practise!** Practise **every day** to build stamina, confidence and technique. It will make a huge difference! Remember your performance needs to be 100% accurate and full of expression.
- **Learn the key terms.** If you don't understand the terminology, you can't access the questions on the listening exam paper.
- **Listen to a range of music** and start to form some ideas of what your composition will look and sound like.

- **Languagenut** - this is the site we have recently signed up to. Students already have their individual logins and homework is set weekly.
- **Quizlet** - use to practise vocabulary. Make your own flash cards.
- **Wordreference.com** - look up vocabulary (not google translate!).
- **Revision guides** - available to purchase via the Academy, we will be placing an order soon.
- **Enrichment** - Students are identified and invited by letter to enrichment based on achievement/progress. This is reviewed each Praising Stars cycle.

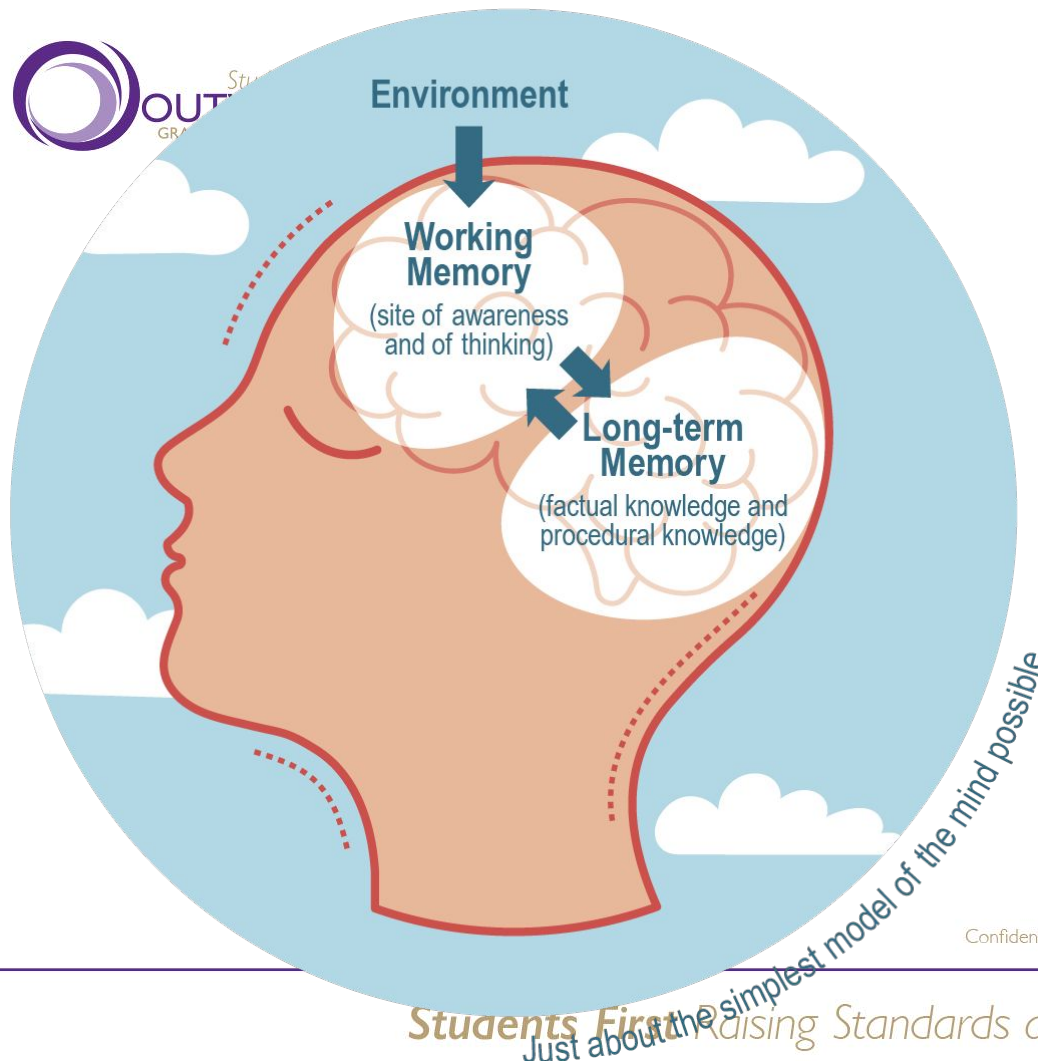
