Below is an overview of key dates and activities over the next few weeks.

Exams & boosters

All students have a personalised exams calendar, which details the exams they have each day. The

final large examinations (full year group) will take place on Friday 16th June. Students will attend the Academy everyday until this point as Year 11 students are following a bespoke timetable which has

boosters directly before each exam and tailored to the contents and skills required for the exams.

To support revision from home subject Directors from across the Trust will continue to provide

online evening master-classes focussing on each subject and each of the areas of study in exams.

Friday 16th June

After students have completed their exams on Friday 16th June they will leave the site, as this will be

their final full day of secondary school at Outwood Academy Portland.

Students who only have the science exam on the morning of Friday 16th June will sign-out

from the Academy site directly after their exam at around 10.30am.

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- Students who are sitting the Geography exam on the afternoon of Friday 16th June will remain onsite and will attend a special Geography booster in preparation for their exam at 1.00pm. They will then sign out after this exam.
- A small cohort of students will be taking the GCSE Polish, Further Maths and Hospitality & Catering exam on Wednesday 21st June 2023. Students taking this exam will receive a personalised plan for their booster and day of the exam.

Rites of passage

On Thursday I5th June 2023, there will be a shirt signing event for students. This will be held at the back of school on the field, 2:30-3:30pm. We are really looking forward to spending this hour together with our wonderful students and hope that they will enjoy the chance to celebrate with each other. At this event there will also be music and treats for students to enjoy. Students will be reminded that there is to be no shirt signing during the academic day and those students who are currently on study leave or those that do not meet academy expectations will unfortunately not be able to attend this event.

We request that students bring a spare shirt to sign, so that they can continue to wear their uniform and to support personal space and contact. Students may also wish to bring a memory book to be signed by peers and staff.

On Wednesday 28th June students will be celebrating at their Prom. This is always a wonderful opportunity for students to come together and celebrate their hard work and friendship with peers and staff.

Year II Results day

Students and families are invited to attend the academy on Thursday 24th August 2023 to collect and celebrate their results from 9.00-11.00am. Academy staff and careers specialists are on hand to support students with their results and their next steps.
