Mock Assessment Update

I would like to inform you that all Year 11 students will be undertaking mock assessments between week commencing **7**th **March and 14**th **March.** This is an essential opportunity for students to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding prior to the summer exam season. It will enable students to experience exam conditions and demonstrate their knowledge and understanding to help inform next steps to ensure maximum success.

I am pleased to report that our Year 11 students have been working extremely hard to ensure they unlock their full potential in the upcoming exam period. Teaching and support staff continue to support students to plug any gaps in knowledge, and are providing extensive support and resources to promote success much of this can be found in your child's Google Classrooms.

It is vital that students attend these assessments as the evidence will also be used to finalise predicted grades to support applications to Further Education. Therefore it is important that we have a precise and accurate picture of attainment at this stage.
